Diamond Creek Community Centre Masterplan

Nillumbik Shire Council is preparing a masterplan for redevelopment and future use of Diamond Creek Community Centre and the immediate surrounds. The project is being completed in partnership with State Government.

Background

In 2006, Council approved Diamond Creek twenty20, an integrated plan which guides future development in Diamond Creek.

Diamond Creek twenty20 identifies the need for a shared multi-use centre in Diamond Creek, which provides for a broad cross-section of the community.

This project will build on previous plans by investigating options for redeveloping the Centre as a venue for community services and programs.

Project funding

The Department of Planning and Community Development will contribute \$30,000 towards the Diamond Creek Community Centre Masterplan project.

Council has allocated \$40,000 towards the masterplan in the 2012–13 budget.


